Comments: At the time of the inspection, the storage space where toxic products and cleaning supplies are stored was unlocked. Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The operator immediately locked the storage space. Deficiency is now compliant			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	May 13, 2024	
Comments: The children water bottles were not labelled with the name. In order to prevent and control communicable diseases and illness the operator must ensure personal belongings are identified.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	May 13, 2024	
Comments: At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance monitor observed food from home that was not labelled. Food brought from home must be labelled with the child's name and refrigerated as required.
