Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The operator immediately locked the storage space. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The children water bottles were not labelled with the name. In order to prevent and control communicable diseases and illness the operator must ensure personal belongings are identified.

Comments: At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance monitor observed food from home that was not labelled. Food brought from home must be labelled with the child's name and refrigerated as required.

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection.

The following were verified at the time of the visit:

- Child to staff ratio
- If storage space for toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies is locked and inaccessible
- if all required documents were posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility
- if food brought from home is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated as required
- If personal belongings such as water bottles were labelled

At the time of the inspection, the operator informs the QAM that a child attending the facility had a fever the night before. (the parent informed the operator). The QAM advice the operator to consult the guidelines for the

Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases in Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) Facilities. That document should also be shared with parents, so they are aware of the exclusion guidelines for specific communicable disease. If the operator has any question regarding the document, she can contact public health.
