General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on October 23, 2024.

During the observation, children were seen engaging in indoor free play and enjoying snack time. Proper handwashing practices were noted during the transition to indoor activities, reflecting adherence to hygiene protocols.

Educators reported that the children are currently fascinated by creating with loose parts and exploring the natural world. They are actively bringing elements of the outdoors inside, using art to observe the changing seasons. Throughout the observation, educators demonstrated positive language and provided gentle reminders to guide the children. Their active participation in children's activities was evident, enhancing the learning experience.

The facility maintains a daily incident log, ensuring that any incidents are documented appropriately. Parents of children present at the center are welcomed and granted entry at any time. Important documents, including the license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and orders for compliance, are displayed in a clearly visible and prominent area. Additionally, evacuation procedures are prominently posted, ensuring that safety protocols are easily accessible.

The environment within the facility is set up to be inviting, with materials arranged to encourage play. Selected books reflect the children's interests, and a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys is available. Several well-defined learning centers were observed, including areas for building, reading, dramatic play, and science. The learning and play areas are well defined, with several pieces of children's artwork proudly displayed throughout the facility. Toxic products, including chemical cleaners, are securely locked and inaccessible to children, ensuring safety. Drinking water is provided continuously throughout the day.

In terms of curriculum, daily activities are thoughtfully planned and documented in the program. The curriculum offers opportunities for both individual and group experiences, fostering various forms of literacy within the indoor environment. Children are encouraged to express their creativity, explore the arts and sciences, experience accomplishments, problem-solve, and develop trusting, respectful, and supportive relationships.
