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### General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The child-to-staff ratio was respected during the inspection.

The following elements were verified:

- Daily routine
- Indoor play area and material
- Washrooms
- Storage space
- Personal belongings
- Diaper changing
- If all required documents are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility
- Children's records
- Signed consent in the children's records

The Quality Assurance Monitor discussed emergency contact information in children's profiles with the administrator. During the review, it was noted that some profiles contained incomplete address details for emergency contacts, with only the city listed instead of the full address. The intent of requiring parents to provide a complete address is to determine whether the emergency contact is located within one hour of the facility in case an emergency pickup is required. According to Regulation 24(1)(iv), each child's profile must include the name, full address, and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency when the parent or guardian cannot be reached.

Moving forward, full address details must be provided for both emergency contacts in all children's profiles.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children sleeping and waking up from their nap. The educators were observed responding to the needs of the children who needed to be rocked back to sleep, cuddled after

waking up or drinking a bottle of milk. Once the children were all awake, they proceeded with the diaper and hand-washing routine. The children had their afternoon snack (Lunch boxes). The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the children transitioning to the outdoor play area. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
