General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on February 20, 2025.

During the monitoring inspection children were observed participating in both indoor and outdoor play. Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in skating at the community rink, reading books, creating art projects with clay, and engaging in imaginary play with costumes. Throughout the inspection, educators were observed using positive language and providing gentle reminders. During outdoor play, educators actively participated in the children's activities, fostering an engaging and supportive play environment.

The facility maintains a daily incident log and ensures that outdoor play occurs for at least one hour within each four-hour block of time when the majority of children are present, weather permitting. A clearly visible and prominent area is designated for posting the license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. The daily routine is posted, and evacuation procedures are clearly displayed in prominent locations.

The room is thoughtfully arranged to create an inviting atmosphere, with materials strategically set up to encourage play. Books are carefully selected to reflect the children's current interests. The facility offers a varied supply of suitable equipment, materials, books, and toys. Drinking water is readily available throughout the day.

The facility provides opportunities for both individual and group experiences, supporting a dynamic and inclusive learning environment. Various forms of literacy are integrated into the indoor environment. Portfolios are being actively completed with the children, and several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility, reflecting the children's experiences and learning journeys.
