Comments: During the review of employee files, the inspector noted that one file contained only a criminal record check. Each staff member must have both a criminal record check and a vulnerable sector check at least every five years. The employee left the premises to visit the nearby RCMP office, obtained the vulnerable sector check, and provided it to the inspector. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the review of the employee files, the inspector observed that one file contained only a criminal record check. Each staff member records must include both a criminal and vulnerable record check. Comments: The inspector observed, in the outdoor play area, the presence of stagnant water in tires. Stagnant water in an outdoor play area can pose several health and safety risks for children. The outdoor play area must be maintained safe and free of hazards. To ensure a safe and hazard-free environment, the inspector recommends implementing a routine cleanup of the outdoor play area before each use.			

General Comments
<p>The inspector is on site to conduct the renewal inspection.</p> <p>During the visit, the following activities were observed: morning outdoor free play, lunch time, indoor free play, and free crafting in one classroom.</p> <p>The inspector is unable to observe the vehicle used for school-age children's transportation, as there is no school on the day of the inspection and the vehicle is not on site. The Quality Assurance Monitor will verify this during the next monitoring inspection.</p>

General Comments

A discussion is held with the operator regarding the outdoor play area. The designated area for school-aged children is the Norton Elementary School Park. Since this park is not part of the daycare's facilities, it was not inspected during the renewal inspection. It is the operator's responsibility to ensure that the outdoor play area is safe for children. Any safety concerns must be communicated to the school so that corrective measures can be taken.

The inspector observed an expired EpiPen. The inspector recommends the operator to discuss with the parents. The operator confirm that a follow-up has already been done with the parents regarding this.

The inspector also clarified that eligible educators must complete the required 10 hours of professional development before the permit expiration date of December 31, 2025.

Another discussion addressed children's personal belongings to ensure that all items are labeled with the child's name.

The ratio is respected throughout the inspection.
