General Comments		

A Monitoring Inspection took place on September 13, 2024.

During the visit, children were observed engaging in outdoor free play. Educators noted that the children are currently very interested in outdoor activities, exploring the natural forest around the property, as well as working on creative projects indoors. The educators were seen using positive language and providing gentle reminders, actively participating in the children's activities during outdoor play.

The facility follows safety protocols, with parents being notified of any incidents, and incident report forms completed for reportable occurrences. Outdoor play is scheduled for at least one hour in every four-hour block when most children are present, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted, and important documents such as the license, inspection reports, and orders for compliance are displayed in a clearly visible location. The daily routine and evacuation procedures are also posted prominently.

The room is set up in an inviting manner, with materials arranged to encourage play. Books have been selected based on the children's interests, and their artwork is displayed at eye level with their names and dates. The facility is well-stocked with a variety of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Toxic products, including cleaners, are locked away and inaccessible to children, and drinking water is available throughout the day.

The curriculum is thoughtfully planned, with daily activities documented and designed to foster creativity, exploration of the arts and sciences, and problem-solving. There are also opportunities for the children to develop respectful, trusting relationships. Open-ended art activities were observed in several areas of the facility.
