General Comments					

A Monitoring Inspection occurred February 7, 2025.

Children were observed during outdoor free play. It was observed that the children are currently highly engaged in an indoor marketplace, caring for new fish in the tank, propagating snake plants, sledding outdoors, and building forts in the forest. Educators were observed using positive language and giving gentle reminders. Open-ended questions are asked by educators and actively listening to answers, using paraphrasing to ensure they heard correctly. Outdoors educators are playing an active role in children's activities.

Daily incident log is maintained. Parents are advised of incidents and incident report forms are completed in the event of reportable incidents. Parents of children present at the center are granted entry at any time. Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children receiving services are in attendance-weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted. A clearly visible and prominent place is available to post the license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, orders for compliance.

The room is set up and inviting, the materials set up invite the children to play. Books have been selected that reflect the children's interests. Children's art has been displayed at eye level. Child's name and date are included. Well defined learning / play areas were observed, and several pieces of the children's artwork were displayed throughout the facility. Toxic products such as chemical products and cleaners are locked and inaccessible to the children. Drinking water is provided throughout the day. Opportunities are open for individual and group experiences. Opportunities to express creativity/explore the arts and sciences/experience accomplishments/problem solve/develop trusting, respectful and supportive relationships.
