The responsible educator on site informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that the renewal of the certification was completed in December 2025, but the copy was not inserted in her file at that location. A copy of the valid First Aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor by email. The staff in question can never be left alone with the children until the proof of certification is sent.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on-site in the afternoon to conduct a monitoring inspection. General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the responsible educator regarding sending an incident report if the facility is closed in reason of a power outage. The responsible educator will send the incident report by email.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children arriving at the centre from school. The educators prepared a leprechaun gold coin seek and find in the outdoor play area. The children were engaged in finding a gold coin to exchange it for a chocolate coin. The educator also set up the indoor play area as a visit from the leprechaun. The toilet was colored with green colorant, green tape was added to create a labyrinth, and footprints of mud was created. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the dramatic play center created as a birthday party as per the interest of the children. An Olympic theme was observed on the walls and a giant floor book with the children's creations and activities based on the interest of the children. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
