<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>During the morning monitoring inspection, the infants and 2-year-olds were observed participating in a variety of activities, including snack time, painting, and outdoor play. The classroom environments were well-organized and furnished with a wide range of age-appropriate materials. All materials were fully accessible to the children for the duration of the inspection. The educators were observed engaging at the children's level, participating in conversations and play.</p> <p>The documentation displayed both inside and outside the facility was current and accurately reflected the children's ongoing play experiences. Webbing, photographs, learning stories, and children's artwork were purposefully arranged to highlight learning and developmental progress.</p> <p>New staff files were reviewed.</p> <p>Incident logs, fire drill records, infant/toddler daily sheets, and attendance records were also reviewed.</p>
