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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including gross motor activities, art, music and movement, building, outdoor play and sensory opportunities. The preschool children in Room #7 were exploring the small climber and jumping on the stepping stones that were set out to encourage children to engage in gross motor play. A small group of children joined their educator for songs in the reading area, when the educator gave out rhythm sticks the rest of the children joined in for some music and movement. A group of preschool children in Room #8 were exploring clay and loose parts; one child made a purse, and the educator gathered more materials to help the other children create clay purses too. The children in Room #9 were exploring cutting different materials at an invitation set up on the Tuff Tray.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments that support the children's current interests (treasure hunts, animal footprints, forts, rocket ships and sensory play). Documentation of the children's learning is displayed in the front entryway for parents to see.</p> <p>Educators were observed using positive child guidance techniques by offering children choices, redirecting behaviours, and supporting the children in problem solving independently.</p> <p>Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines and before snack. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (6) review was completed. Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (4/6) requirement.</p>
