<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection - PreK Program Only:</p> <p>Children and educators observed during snack, transition times and outdoor play this morning. The children explored the playground equipment and played games with a variety of different balls.</p> <p>The indoor play area was set-up with a variety of invitations and materials for the children to explore freely. The children have planted tomatoes, herbs and cucumbers and are learning about how plants grow. They are also learning about baby guppies and how to care for them.</p> <p>QA Monitor discussed ways to set-up and replenish the dramatic play area as it is becoming unorganized and cluttered. Recommending displaying materials on tops of shelving and window ledge, adding some plants and photos, and organizing materials in labelled bins.</p> <p>Surfacing around the playground structures is pooling away from fall zones. Ensure surfacing is evenly distributed with a rake in fall zones.</p> <p>Crackers and yogurt were served for morning snack. Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (1) review was completed; all required documents are in place. Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (2/2) requirement.</p>
