Comments: The large playground only has pea gravel. There used to be a sand box but that was removed during winter and not replaced. A second surface must be added.							

General Comments

This morning children were involved in different play and activities. The Clever Cubs were reading a story together about insects and bugs and the staff had a scorpion from Afghanistan inside resin mould to show the children.

Shortly after my arrival, everyone went outside.

During outside time, the staff in the preschool playground were engaged with the children, playing with them, some were giving back rides, others were doing bubbles with the children. A lot of laughter and smiles were heard by both children and educators. Sand should be added to the infant sand box.

During nap time, children who don't nap where given quiet activities. In one room, staff and children were sitting around a table with a lamp and engaged in quiet activities.

The Centre is clean and organized and the children have materials of all required categories. The infant room has more materials since my last inspection.

Pre-planned program is evident and documented. Learning stories and children's creations are posted on the walls.
