When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility the children were cleaning up the indoor play environment before washing their hands and sitting down at the table to eat their lunch.

After the children were done their lunch, they put on their outdoor play clothing on and went outside to play.

When the children came back indoors, the educators recognized when the children were satiating from their free play activities and set up a "spa" activity and the children's attention was redirected.

The educators used positive child guidance strategies such as redirection and checked in with the children when unkind words were being used by the children to their peers. The educators reminded the children to use kind words with their peers.

The indoor play environment had a good variety of play resources and a number of play centres set up for the children to engage in.
