<p>General Comments</p> <p>Children were just coming in from outside for snack when licensing staff arrived. Children went to the washroom and filled up water bottles before sitting to eat. Some children began to play in the room. Children that mentioned they didn't have any snacks were provided with a prepackaged snack by the educator.</p> <p>A second educator was being trained and learning the daily routine with the regular educator. The second educator cannot be left alone with children and must have all their checks completed before being counted in the child-to-staff ratio. This was only their second visit to the facility to learn from the regular educator.</p> <p>The room has two walls with the children's artwork posted. There is a printer available for children to request coloring photos and there is an assortment of paper, writing utensils, markers, and art materials accessible to the children to create. A stapler is available, and children were observed stapling their artwork to the bulletin board. The children's names are posted on one wall in the form of a caterpillar and a birthday poster with each child's name and birthday.</p> <p>A daily routine is posted and a plan for each day with an activity. The educator shared that she plans something for each day but children sometimes request to just go outside to play so she follows their lead. They took planting outside one day to enjoy the sun and learn about planting. They went for a walk to the store yesterday for a freezie and little field trip.</p> <p>The educator gave reminders of going back outside during snack and after a period of play, they lined up in the hall. The educator counts the children to ensure everyone is present during transitions. A large wagon is brought outside with resources, games, and water bottles. If children need to go in to use the washroom or get a drink out of the fountain, the educator stands in the doorway to observe the child inside and children outside.</p> <p>An incident occurred between two children on the playground and the educator quickly attended to the child that was hurt providing an ice pack and comfort. The educator then spoke to the second child reminding them of being nice to one another and had them talk to the child they hurt. The educator documents incidents on incident reports for each child and shares with parents.</p>
