General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the facility just as the children were having snack. All food is brought from home, and the younger children had their snack in their highchairs and the older preschoolers sat at the child sized table. The play area was clean and bright with an abundance of materials such as a playhouse, small ride on toys, a chalk board, a kitchen set, a variety of loose parts, baby dolls, stuffed animals, a child sized couch, and large shaped blocks for climbing and building. There were pictures of the children engaging in their daily activities posted on the wall and the operator sends pictures to the parents as well throughout the day.

After snack everyone went outside to play. The operator applied bug spray and sunscreen and made sure everyone drank some of the water that they brought out with them. The outdoor play area is fenced, consists of grass and has a large maple tree that shades most of the play area. There was a variety of toys available; small slides, a teeter totter, mud kitchen, covered sandbox, a hand pump with water and a basin with floating toys, small picnic table, ride on cars, small bicycles for the older toddlers and a really nice sound wall. The operator was very engaged in the children's play, and they danced and sang and played tag. She helped them with their play and filled the pump with water so they could play with it.

After outside play everyone came in, the operator washed their hands and diapered everyone. She then played games at the table with the children while she set up their lunches. After lunch everyone napped.

The childcare facility was clean and organized and the parent board is posted inside. The child files were verified and up to date. The operator is kind and patient with the children, and the atmosphere was calm and pleasant.
