General Comments

Name of operator

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on March 3, 2025.

Children were observed engaging in both indoor and outdoor free play. Proper handwashing procedures were followed during the transition from outdoor to indoor play. Steps or platforms were available to ensure children could safely access regular-sized toilets and sinks.

The educator stated that the children are currently interested in loose parts building, knitting projects, making a leprechaun trap, snow painting, and creating bird seed feeders. Throughout the observation, the educator used positive language and provided gentle reminders to support children's engagement and behavior. Outdoors, the educator played an active role in the children's activities, participating alongside them.

A daily incident log is maintained, and parents of enrolled children are granted entry to the center at any time. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted as required. A designated, highly visible area displays the center's license, current inspection and monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additionally, the daily routine and evacuation procedures are posted in a prominent location.

The facility has well-defined learning and play areas, with children's artwork displayed throughout. Traffic areas, including outdoor walkways, are kept clean and free of clutter. Toxic products, such as chemical cleaners, are locked away and inaccessible to children. Drinking water is readily available throughout the day. Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of an appropriate depth to ensure safety.

Daily activities are purposefully planned and documented within the program. Children have opportunities to express creativity, explore the arts and sciences, experience a sense of accomplishment, problem-solve, and develop trusting, respectful, and supportive relationships.
