General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on May 16, 2025.

During the inspection the facility experienced an unexpected closure due to a power outage. Educators reported that families were promptly contacted for early pick-up. The children were received at the facility, and parents arrived for pick-up. During the closure, educators ensured that a supply of water was available for handwashing and restroom use. An incident report documenting the temporary closure was available and reviewed on site.

The indoor environment was rich in materials and provided opportunities for both individual and group learning experiences. Several well-organized and inviting learning centers were noted, including dramatic play, open-ended art, a reading area, and a creatively designed Starbucks-themed center. These areas encouraged exploration and imaginative play. The facility also had a wide range of materials designated for outdoor use, including sports equipment, art materials, and sensory items. These resources supported active and creative engagement in the outdoor play space. A review of documentation confirmed that all required records were up to date and complete. This included incident logs, monthly fire drills, monthly outdoor play yard checklists, and daily attendance records.

A conversation with the Administrator highlighted several strengths of the program, including a well-maintained indoor play space and purposefully planned activities that reflect the interests of the children. Child-led planning was evident, particularly in the preparation of special events. One area for growth was identified in the outdoor environment, specifically the condition of the wooden boards in the play area. The Administrator shared that a grant is currently being explored to fund their replacement in the future.
