General Comments
<p>Licensing Staff arrived at the Centre to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Children were enjoying stations while one of the Educators was preparing an activity. The children were seen playing with Lego, puzzles and building their own robots with cardboard, tinfoil and other craft supplies.</p> <p>An Educator prepared a Science Experiment where the children got to see how a polar bear felt while being in the Arctic Ocean. A large bin was filled with ice cubes and cold water and a lined Ziploc baggy floating inside. The children got to put their hand inside the lined baggy which represented a polar bear, and then the icy water. A large book "My Giant Animals of the World" book was on display with pictures and facts about animals in the Arctic.</p> <p>There were several displays throughout the classroom that aligned with the weekly theme. Animal prints which were laminated and, in a basket, as well as some books about beavers, woodlands and snakes were seen. It is evident there is purposeful planning. Learning stories, pictures and monthly calendar were observed. The Educators were engaged with the children throughout the visit, often playing and sitting with them, engaged in conversation.</p>
