General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, a group of children were sitting with an Educator building with Lego. Another Educator was observed sitting at the tables with a child as they did a dinosaur I-spy game. The classroom was tidy, organized and had a variety of activities set up for the children to freely explore.

The children have been showing an interest in dinosaurs lately. Several dinosaur themed activities were observed such as laminated pages with dinosaur fossils, a matching game and fun facts about dinosaurs. Later in the afternoon the children created a car factory out of Lego. The children and Educators were heard talking about their jobs in the factory, some were building transportation trucks for broken cars while others built new cars. The Educator was heard giving several gentle reminders before cleaning up for afternoon snack. The tables were cleaned, and all children washed their hands before eating. After snack time, the children packed up their personal belongings and got ready for outside.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. Educators were observed offering support during a disagreement between peers. The Educator spoke with kindness and in a calm tone with the children as she helped them navigate through the disagreement. Child and staff profiles were reviewed and contained all required documents.
