General Comments
Monitoring Inspection: A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning to follow up on orders for compliance ahead of upcoming Renewal Inspection. It was determined that the previously issued order for dramatic play materials remains outstanding. QA Monitor stated that this order would be required to be moved to the upcoming Renewal Inspection as the inspection has been postponed due to outstanding orders on Monitoring Inspection. Ensure materials are replenished. QA Monitor noted some improvements with the cleanliness of the environment; continued support and daily cleaning routines are to be implemented. Recommendations were left with staff on ways to make the environment more inviting for the children. Examples of items to add, but not limited to plants, soft lighting, photos, documentation supporting current interests and experiences, challenges, art pieces, items from nature and age-appropriate books displayed throughout the room. QA Monitor discussed utilizing the window ledges and tops of shelving to display materials, books and children's creations. Purposeful planning was observed to be documented on planning sheets however; the interests of the children

and their learning experiences are not evident throughout the environment; to be added.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
