Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the protective surfacing in the outdoor play area. The current protective surfacing under the stationary equipment is compact and not of appropriate depth. An application for change to change the protective surfacing under the stationary equipment was sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor. In the meantime, to ensure safety, the children are prohibited to use the stationary equipment. In order to comply with this requirement until the change is complete, the protective surfacing can also be turned over or raked (to reach the appropriate depth).

At the time of the visit, the followings were verified:

- Daily activities include:

- Outdoor play area materials and equipment

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor remeasured one classroom. The allocation of space form will be updated and sent to the operator as soon as possible. The outdoor play area was also measured during the visit.
