**General Comments**

The following elements were verified at the time of the monitoring inspection:

- The child-educator ratio.
- Posted at the entrance: the daily routine, fire evacuation instructions, the name of the administrator, the names and phone numbers of the quality-assurance mentor and the inspector, and any reported illness when required. The inspector's and quality-assurance mentor's cards were provided to be visibly posted at the entrance of the facility. The quality-assurance mentor also provided her card containing her contact information.
- Emergency and fire-drill records indicate that drills are conducted each month. The months of January through May have been completed.
- A maintenance and inspection plan for fixed equipment indicates that checks are performed monthly. The months of January through May have been completed.
- Daily attendance records for the children are present on site.
- Circulation areas and outdoor walkways are free of obstacles and hazards.
- Outdoor play takes place for at least one hour during every four-hour period.

At the time of the monitoring inspection, the quality-assurance mentor observed free play in one group, where some children were finishing their drawings. The educator then read the book *Magic Pegasus* to the children. In another group, the children were discovering a guided activity: a sensory bin with water, soap, and plastic food items. One child decided to take a doll from a center and wash it. All the children gathered around the sensory bin, and the educator encouraged them to explore. In another group, the children went to the bathroom and washed their hands (with educator supervision). In another group, the children were getting ready to go outside. All the children were outdoors at the time of the monitoring inspection.

The quality-assurance mentor provided Public Health posters regarding communicable diseases.
