General Comments

The facility was at the park when licensing staff arrived. Upon arrival at the park, licensing staff recognized orange hats on each of the children to identify them associated with the licence and one other licence. The operator brings a wagon to the park each day filled with a variety of resources supporting the curriculum such as clipboards with paper, writing utensils, books, buckets, spoons, and items to play in the sand and pea gravel.

The operator noticed one child was getting hungry and offered a snack to the children. The children joined another home centre on a blanket set out for snack. Children received a wipe to clean their hands before beginning snack independently choosing what they would like to eat. The operator had packed a small highchair for the youngest child setting in up at the edge of the blanket with a tray for food to be placed on.

After snack, the operator offered a tab tag game that included a belt for one child and the other children would chase the child and try to pull off one of the tabs or tentacles, as the operators suggested. The children had a large space to run and were laughing as they tried to catch the person with the belt and tabs. When children grew tired of the game, they asked to drive their bikes on the pavement. The operator ensured children put on a helmet securely and drove a bike appropriate to their age and size.

The operator and Quality Assurance Monitor discussed summer plans for vacation and the operator was reminded to send off any vacation days to licensing staff and give parents 30 days' notice of vacation dates. The operator is considerate of the plans of families and trying to work their own vacation in alignment with families.
