General Comments
<p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including stories, music and movement, dramatic play, painting, playdoh, water play and outdoor play. Each indoor play area is set-up with a variety of invitations and materials displayed on low open shelving for the children to explore freely. Real-life materials have been added to the dramatic play areas to support the children's ongoing interests.</p> <p>Improvements have been made to the outdoor play areas since last Monitoring Inspection. A variety of materials and equipment have been added to the outdoor play areas. New materials include climbing structures, a playhouse, a sandbox, and items that create adequate shade.</p> <p>QA Monitor discussed purposeful planning with acting site supervisor. Each room has documentation completed on their planning sheets however, the documentation pieces within the rooms are not current or ongoing. Examples of documentation to be added learning stories, webs, ongoing group projects, questions, children's quotes, and open-ended art pieces.</p> <p>Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines, diapering, after outdoor play and before mealtimes.</p> <p>Homemade chicken noodle soup, tuna and egg salad sandwiches and milk were served for lunch today.</p>

General Comments

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily Attendance Records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.

Infant Daily Information sheets were observed to be up to date.

New staff file (3) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
