General Comments

Licensing staff discussed pre-planned programming with the administrator and the manager. Through conversations with the educators, they were able to articulate how their activities are based off of the children's interests. One of the educators in the infant room showed me their dog wall because one of the infants has a large interest in dogs. The educator placed pictures of educator's dogs and dogs of some of the children on the wall.

Please expand on the connection between the children's interests by using a method to pre-plan their program such as webbing or journaling to help demonstrate that planning is a process that involves engaging the children and reflecting on their interests, passions, strengths and abilities. Licensing staff advised the administrator to reach out to their curriculum consultant for best practices in this area.

Learning stories, photos of the children, and the children's artwork are some of the methods that the educators are using for documentation.

Each classroom had photo permissions posted on the wall. The educators are very aware of children who are not allowed to have their photos posted in the private social media group. Severe allergies are also posted as outlined in the regulations.

The filing system has improved since last visit. The files are organized and complete and documentation is easily verified by licensing staff.

Although the wind was colder today, each age group was outside. Educators were observed working together to dress the children to lessen transition times for them.

Educators are very engaged with the children. They were observed sitting with the children at lunch and rubbing backs during nap time to create a calm atmosphere. Hugs were given when children were upset and the educators were heard validating the children's feelings.

General Comments

I can now recommend facility for licensing pending a current Fire inspection.
