## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on November 28, 2024.

During the inspection, children were observed engaging in indoor free play. Educator shared that children are currently interested in using a new drawing projector, being active outdoors on the local beach, and participating in upcoming outings to the Grand Manan Nursing Home. Positive child guidance techniques were consistently observed, including educator interacting at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using positive

language, offering choices, and supporting decision-making.

The facility allows parents unrestricted access during operational hours. Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in every four-hour block, weather permitting. The daily routine and weekly menu, including substitutions, are posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are displayed prominently. Life-threatening allergies are clearly posted, and allergy information is accessible in the food preparation area. Books reflecting children's interests were available, and the facility offered a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, and toys. Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, with children's artwork displayed throughout. Traffic areas and outdoor walkways were clean and clutter-free, and toxic products were securely stored out of children's reach. Drinking water was available throughout the day.

The curriculum provided opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Various forms of literacy were incorporated into the indoor environment, alongside activities promoting creativity, arts, sciences, problemsolving, and building respectful relationships. Learning story documentation was also observed, showcasing the children and educator interests.
