General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today.

The children were observed reading books, playing with blocks, sliding on the play structure, having snack, and having lunch. The operator and associated person were down on floor engaged in play with the children.

The environment was set up with a wide range of materials. Opportunities for sensory play, recognizing patterns and colors, and counting were observed. Licensing staff discussed with the operator the idea of creating an art and science shelf to add to the main room. This would give children more opportunities to explore art and science at all times throughout the day.

The operator was observed demonstrating counting and breathing techniques with a child who was upset. These techniques were successful.

A documentation book titled "A Day of Play" was displayed in the play environment. Licensing staff discussed with the operator how she could take her documentation to the next level. This would be done by adding photos and a description of the learning that is occurring and then referencing the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework and planning what is next to scaffold the children's learning.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, daily attendance sheets, menu, menu substitutions.

Operator and associated person files were viewed. All of the child files were reviewed.

Licensing staff discussed with the operator the following:

- 1. The operator's plan to take an infant when a new space becomes available as per designation requirements. Licensing staff will send policy 901 to operator.
- 2. Ensuring that outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of
