A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning. Children were observed during snack and inside play. Each room contained several well-defined learning / play areas - Building, Dramatic Play, Reading, Mark Marking, Loose Parts, Arts & Crafts, etc. Each of these areas were observed to have ample supplies and materials. Several forms of documentation were observed in each room - children's artwork, learning stories, photos, visual schedules, etc. Positive Child Guidance techniques were observed by all educators. Examples included: educators sitting with the children, educators conversing with the children, educators using positive language, and educators offering choices. Attendance Records were observed and accurate. The infant daily information sheets were observed and were UpToDate. Incident logs were observed. The Parent Board was observed, and it contained the following documents: License, contact information, allergies, daily schedule, and emergency evacuation. Today's Monitoring Inspection Report to be added to Parent Board. Infant Room (Side A & B) - A conversation was had with educators and administrator regarding spaces per side / ratio. Side A measures for 6 infants. Side B measures for 6 infants. At no time, can Side A have more than 6 infants. At no time, can Side B have more than 6 infants. Educators to ensure that the number of children grouped at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare center shall not be more than the number that requires two educators (Please review 8.1.2 Child-to-staff ratios for same age group, 9(5), page 56 of the Operator's Manual.
