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General Comments
Monitoring Inspection: Children and educators were observed engaged in a variety of activities throughout the morning, including dramatic play, art experiences, outdoor play, and gross motor activities. In the infant room, educators were observed at the children's level, engaging in meaningful conversations and following the children's lead as they explored a variety of age-appropriate materials. Preschool children were observed in the outdoor play area exploring invitations provided by educators. Opportunities were evident for children to engage in healthy risk-taking and test their limits in a safe and supportive environment. Educators maintained appropriate supervision, stepping in when needed and providing support to children while allowing them opportunities to explore independently and develop their skills. The indoor play areas appear clean, and well organized. Materials and equipment are accessible to children in a way that supports independent play. Purposeful planning is evident throughout the learning environments through documentation that reflects children's interests, experiences, and ongoing learning. Documentation is current, displayed at the children's level, and demonstrates how educators are building on children's ideas and extending learning through planned experiences. Chicken, quinoa and veggies were served for lunch. Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play and before mealtimes. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (3) review was completed; all required documents are in place. Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (6/9) requirement.
