General Comments

-Late morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection

-Ratio was respected during the visit

-Centre has the proper number of functioning and available toilets and sinks, one potty chair or training seat is provided, and a step or platforms are provided to allow children to reach regular sized toilets or sinks.

-The diaper changing station is found, in the bathroom on the main floor, individual space is provided for diapers and changing necessities. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non-absorbent layer, it is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink and children are always supervised during diaper changing.

-It was discussed with the administrator that since the 3-year-old room is on the second floor, and if a child in that room would not be potty trained, it would be necessary to have the proper equipment in the bathroom found in that room. The reasoning behind it is to always keep the supervision of the children.

-Daily routine in the center includes; Outdoor play time at least once every 4 hour blocks time when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily rest period that meets the children's needs.

-Each napping child has a cot or nap mat that is appropriate for their height. Each child that is under 15 months

has a designated crib that meets the crib regulation.

-Rest area for children under 15 months is separate from play area

-There is a space of at least 46 cm between rest equipment and all nap equipment is washable and nonabsorbent

-Each cot is stored so there is no contact with another napping equipment

-Discuss with the administrator and staff the change in the regulation when it comes to hot beverages.

-Guidance of children is done in a positive and respectful way

-Medications are kept under key and out of reach from the children

-Non-prescribed medication are in the original container but were not labeled with the child's name and dosage, proper correction will be made. It was also discussed with an educator to never give children medicine from a pre-filled syringe.

-Parent board is posted in the entrance which is a visible and prominent place. The routine of the day is missing on both parent boards.

Observations : When arriving at the center 3 and 4-years-old were playing outside, they came in washed their hands, ate their lunch and transitioned to free play. Infants and two's were already eating their lunch, once they were done they washed their hands and faces and went into nap.
