Discussion was had with administrator and educators regarding documentation of checks of sleeping infants. When infants younger than 15 months of age are sleeping in cribs, staff members do not need to be in the rest area; however, a physical check of the children must occur every 15 minutes. These checks are documented with staff signatures and the times of the check.

Some educators have not yet completed the required professional learning hours; however, a plan is in place to complete them before the licence renewal date of April 30th. The administrator will provide a copy of the professional training hours record once they are completed.

Outdoor play area will be reinspected once the snow melts. During the visit, infant and preschool children were observed Diaper changing, nap time and mealtime were also observed.
