General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the afternoon to conduct a monitoring inspection.

The following elements were verified:

- Daily routine
- Rest Area
- Premises
- Administrative records maintained on site
- Outdoor play area and equipment
- Transportation
- Premises

While taking ratio in the outdoor play area, one educator states that she has 17 children although the Quality Assurance Monitor counted 19 children present. While asking the ratio to the second educator present, she stated that 19 children were present. The attendance sheet also showed 19 children signed in for that day. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the importance of the educators knowing how many children they have always present.

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding outdoor play area material for the children. Although it was observed that the children were engaged in different types of play and imaginative play. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommends that more material and toys be added for the children in the outdoor play area. A reminder to follow the manufacturer's instructions while adding a fixed structure is also given to the administrator. If a homemade stationary equipment is without manufacturer's instructions, the operator must follow the CSA guidelines.

The Quality Assurance Monitor also had a discussion with the administrator regarding personal belongings. The children's water bottle and lunch boxes must be labelled with the name of the children.

The children were observed transitioning to the outdoor play area. The children were observed playing on top of

two small dirt hills, digging in the hill. A group of children were observed in the shade area playing an imaginary game and a guess who game. The children then transitioned to the facility playground to play. An outing was planned for the afternoon at a local facility to eat their lunch and swim.
