General Comments
During the afternoon ASP session, children were engaged in three separate activity areas: outdoors, an art room, and a dance room. Educators were present and actively supervising and supporting children in all locations. Art Activity A local artist facilitated an art session in one room, where children were learning painting techniques and creating individual cupcake-themed artwork. An educator remained present throughout the activity, providing assistance and support as needed. Children were engaged and focused on their projects. Dance Activity In a second indoor room, an educator led a structured dance activity. The session began with a warm-up to prepare the children for movement. The group then practiced a dance routine they had been working on, inspired by the Broadway production Footloose. The educator participated alongside the children, modeling enthusiasm and offering positive guidance. Encouragement was consistently provided, and children were supported in taking leadership roles within the choreography. Outdoor Play Outdoors, children were engaged in various forms of play, including using the mud kitchen, swinging in hammocks, and playing in forts they had constructed. The educator reported that shelter-building has been a recent area of interest, and children created the forts using sticks and tarps with some support from educators. Supervision was maintained throughout all outdoor activities.
