General Comments
A renewal inspection was conducted on the licensed program during the afternoon. Upon arrival at the childcare facility, Licensing observed that the school-age children were still attending school. At the conclusion of the school day, Licensing observed the children and educators transitioning to outdoor play in The Meadow. During the outdoor play period, children and educators were observed enjoying their afternoon snack and participating in a variety of activities, including parachute games, climbing on the ninja line, using the tire swings, and balancing on the balance beam. Licensing inspected both indoor learning environments and observed that each space was organized, prepared, and ready to welcome the children should the educators choose to transition indoors later in the day. Licensing recommends adding mulch beneath the ninja line to provide additional protection in areas where tree roots are exposed and may present a tripping hazard. Throughout the inspection, Licensing observed educators actively engaged in the children's learning and play

experiences. Educators demonstrated positive child guidance practices and maintained supportive, respectful interactions with the children.
