General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility as children were transitioning into the classroom for the afternoon program.</p> <p>Upon arrival, some children began eating their snack while others independently chose to engage in play activities at tables and learning centres throughout the room.</p> <p>One activity area included a mark-making station where children were using markers, pastels, paper, and scissors. Another group of children were engaged in a card game, "Go Fish." Two separate groups of children were observed playing chess on the floor.</p> <p>Later in the afternoon, additional activities included children playing "Uno" and others engaging with a container of beads for manipulative play.</p> <p>The educators used positive child guidance strategies while interacting with the children.</p> <p>All child and staff files were complete with the required documentation.</p> <p>Please ensure a "Flexible Daily Schedule" is posted on the communication board for parents to reference if needed.</p> <p>While observing children engaged in outdoor play, it was noted that the outdoor play areas used by school-aged children do not provide sufficient shade to adequately protect them from sun exposure.</p> <p>Although the program closes during the summer months, it remains a licensing requirement under the Early Childhood Services Act that each child has access to a minimum of 4.5 square metres of shade.</p> <p>Please ensure that the required amount of shade is installed and available to children prior to the licensed facility closing in June.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor will follow up on this matter during the next Monitoring Inspection.</p>
