General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on May 20, 2025.

Children were observed during indoor free play. Educators shared that the children are currently interested in a range of activities, including art projects such as polymer clay, drawing, and painting, as well as outdoor activities such as soccer and fine motor beading. Positive child guidance techniques were observed throughout the facility, and educators indoors were actively involved in children's play, offering support and encouragement.

The facility maintains a current and up-to-date daily incident log. The license, current inspection and monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance are posted in a clearly visible and prominent location. The daily routine and evacuation procedures are also posted and easy to locate. The room is well-organized and inviting, with materials thoughtfully arranged to encourage play and exploration. A varied selection of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys is available, and well-defined learning and play areas were observed. Children's artwork is displayed throughout the facility.

Both indoor and outdoor traffic areas are clean and free of clutter, and drinking water is accessible to children throughout the day. Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth to promote safety. The curriculum offers opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Various forms of literacy are present in the indoor environment, supporting the development of language and communication skills.
