### General Comments

Upon licensing staff's arrival for the annual renewal inspection, Educators were preparing for the children's arrival from school. As the children entered, they placed their belongings in their cubbies and transitioned to the indoor environment, which is located in a community gym.

Several activity stations were set up, allowing children to engage freely in their choice of play. Options included completing puzzles, drawing and building with K'nex. Children were also able to eat their snack from home when desired. After a period of free play, the group gathered for carpet time, during which the Educator facilitated a discussion about the afternoon's activities and read a story in an interactive manner. Children then played in the section of the gym where a basketball net and balls are available for children to play actively. An educator was observed playing basketball with the group.

The indoor environment contained a wide variety of age-appropriate materials, including but not limited to craft supplies, a dramatic play area, board games, LEGO, various building blocks, stuffed animals, fidget toys, and books.

Staff and child files were verified. Only positive child guidance was observed throughout the visit.

Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.
