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General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at Busy Beaver to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the group was inside for a bathroom break before transitioning back to the outdoor play space. The outdoor environment offered a variety of play materials such as a swing set, several trucks, balls, climbing structures, a mud kitchen and accessories such as pots, pans and utensils. All outdoor materials were in good condition.

The children started showing an interest in the sandbox while playing outside, so the Educator removed a tarp from the top and opened a plastic bin nearby which was full of shovels, buckets, mini rakes and other play materials to be used in the sand box. The children sat down and were observed scooping sand with their hands and shovels into the buckets to make a sand castle. The Educator was heard encouraging their independence, "look at you, you've almost filled your whole bucket. Remember to tap on the bottom and slowly pull it up!". When it was time to go inside, several gentle reminders were given before the group transitioned inside for free play.

Proper diaper changing procedures were observed and hands were washed as the children entered the indoor environment. The room was decorated with pictures of the children, learning stories and pieces of the children's artwork. This morning the children were interested in a large bin of musical instruments and building with pieces of the play couch. They took turns sharing the instruments, playing along as the Educator sang "Old MacDonald had a Farm". The Educator explained they have been working on sharing and taking turns. The Educator was observed patiently and calmly guiding the children through disagreements over sharing, offering suggestions and acknowledging their feelings. Gentle reminders were heard before the Educator sang the clean-up song and worked with the children to tidy up for lunch time. Proper hand washing was observed before the group sat together to eat.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educator took the time to sit with the children when they were experiencing big feelings and modelled how to work through them. Positive changes have been made to the flexible daily schedule to accommodate the children and their needs. Attendance records were up to date, and the communication board contained all required documents. Weekly planning sheets were posted for families to see as well as a monthly newsletter.
