General Comments

A renewal inspection was conducted today at the licensed home child care facility. Upon arrival, the educator was observed outdoors with the children, who were actively engaged in free play. Activities included exploring leaves, drawing with chalk, playing with kitchen sets, using the slide, and running freely within the designated outdoor space. The operator had the attendance record and first aid kit readily accessible outside, and attendance was properly documented.

The educator demonstrated warm and positive engagement with the children throughout the inspection. Interactions were nurturing, responsive, and developmentally appropriate. The educator was observed joining in play, offering encouragement, and facilitating conversations that supported social and emotional development. Children appeared comfortable, confident, and well-connected to the educator, reflecting a strong sense of trust and belonging within the program.

Upon entering the home, children were observed independently engaging in handwashing routines, demonstrating natural hygiene habits. The indoor learning environment was thoughtfully arranged, with a variety of documented activities visible throughout the space. Child-led exploration was evident, and the educator had intentionally placed props and materials at the children's level to encourage engagement. These included a puppet theatre with hand puppets, open-ended art materials, building blocks, dress-up clothing, and painted stones resembling food items.

Children's artwork was respectfully preserved in protective sleeves, allowing for display without risk of damage. Learning stories were posted throughout the environment, showcasing the children's experiences and developmental progress. The educator maintained a well-organized incident binder ("booboo binder") with all reports neatly filed and accessible for review.

All sleep cots were clean, well-maintained, and individually labeled with each child's bedding. Children brought their own snacks and lunches from home and were clearly labeled to ensure proper handling and identification.
