General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred in the afternoon on December 11, 2025

The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments, including transitions between the two. Transitions for both the preschool and school age groups were supported by educators using visual cues and gentle verbal prompts.

Preschool: Upon arrival, the children were observed eating lunch. After lunch, they transitioned to free play, which included playing in the dress-up area, drawing on doodle boards, and playing with Barbie dolls. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in art, sensory activities, dancing to music, and the class Elf, Snowflake Henry. Documentation was visible throughout the room as well as in the hallway, including photographs, learning webs, learning stories, and children's artwork. Outdoors, the children were observed using Tonka trucks and digging in the snow.

School Age: The children were observed arriving from school and transitioning to the classroom, with several children eating snack after handwashing. Children who did not choose to have a snack were observed drawing, playing in the dramatic play center, and using Rubik's cubes in the loft. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in outdoor activities, especially sliding, baking, and art, specifically drawing, as well as being helpful. Outdoors, the children were observed sliding down the hill on sleds, throwing snowballs, building snowmen, and using shovels to dig in the snow.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, four staff files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the administrator regarding the following:

Recommending that educators in the school age program include more detailed descriptions in their planning book to reflect the intent and outcomes of activities. Adding photos of the learning experiences will provide
