Comments: Three educator files are missing a description of duties and responsibilities. These documents are to be added to the files.

Comments: Three educator files are missing staff-signed statements regarding obligations under the Early Childhood Services Act and Licensing Regulation. These documents are to be added to the files.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (c) staff member records that include (vii) a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate for each administrator and educator.	24(1)(c)(vii)	May 22, 2026	
Comments: One educator file was missing a copy of a valid First Aid (FA) certificate and a valid Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certificate. The operator is to submit to Licensing and add to the educator's file once completed. The educator is not permitted to be left alone.			
28(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall carry out emergency evacuation and fire drills monthly.	28(2)	May 29, 2026	
Comments: Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills have not been completed since December 2025. These drills must be conducted and recorded monthly. The operator indicated that drills have been conducted monthly but not recorded; no documentation was available to support this. Licensing discussed that fire drills must be recorded in real time.			

<b>General Comments</b>
A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon.
The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments including the transition between the

two.

Preschool Room: Upon arrival, the children were observed preparing to transition outdoors. The children indicated that they are currently interested in playing with Barbies, using dump trucks, digging for worms, playing with balls, and building bird nests. Evidence of learning related to spring and the bird life cycle was present in the room, including a learning web. Learning stories were also displayed outside the classroom on the children's cubbies. Outdoors the children were observed digging, pushing the dump trucks, and building a balance bridge with wooden planks and tires.

School-Age: The children were observed arriving from school, washing their hands and heading outdoors to eat snack. After snack the children were observed playing soccer, engaged in a nature scavenger hunt, playing in the wooded area, and swinging on the swings. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in nature, specifically birds, and playing outdoors.

Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The educators were observed to be engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision-making

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, three educator files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
