Preschool Room: The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environment including the transition between the two. Outdoors the children were observed using cars, going down the slide, looking for bugs, climbing the climbing wall, and climbing and jumping off the tires. Indoors the children were observed

eating lunch with handwashing occurring beforehand. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in animals, blocks, and outdoor play.

School Age Room: The school age children were observed transitioning to outdoors. Outdoors the children were observed engaged in a variety of activities that included playing basketball, using the swings, walking the tight rope, building using sticks and logs in the wooded area, playing in the sand box, and using the tire swing.

Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The operator was seen engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision-making.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, daily information sheets, one educator file, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the floor supervisor on the following:

- Educators are to review the Operator's Manual, Section 7: Programming and Daily Routine. Purposeful planning was not evident. Purposeful planning is to be visible through invitations, documentation, and planned activities. The operator is responsible for ensuring the printer is in working order to support educators in printing documentation.
- Recommended protective surfacing under the large tires and climbing equipment to protect a child should they fall.
