General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 2025

The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities across indoor and outdoor environments as well as during transitions between both environments, The observation also included lunchtime.

Outdoors, the children were observed on the ninja line, making loom bracelets, drawing pictures, swinging on the swings, and playing in the wooded area. Indoors the children were observed eating lunch with handwashing occurring beforehand. After lunch, the children transitioned to free play while an educator set up two tables with invitations to play. One table was set up with paint mixed with sand, and the other featured catapults and pinecones.

Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in Pokémon, preforming talent shows/skits, openended art, sensory activities, and outdoor play.

The indoor environment was set up with materials that invited the children to play. This included a fossil dig exploration table and a mural for talents shows/skits. Several forms documentation were visible throughout the room, including photographs, children's print, and artwork. Books were selected to reflect the children's interest.

Traffic areas both indoors and outdoors, were maintained in a clean and clutter-free condition. A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incidents logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
