General Comments

Monitoring Inspection

The school age children were observed transitioning to outdoors. Outdoors the children were observed engaged in a variety of activities that included playing basketball, using the swings, walking the tight rope, building using sticks and logs in the wooded area, playing in the sand box and using the tire swing.

Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The educators were seen engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision-making.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, two educator files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the floor supervisor on the following:

- Educators must ensure that the daily attendance records always accompany the group, including during outdoor play and transitions between spaces. Licensing observed that the attendance records were not taken outdoors with the children.
- Educators are to review the Operator's Manual, Section 7: Programming and Daily Routine. Purposeful planning was not evident. Purposeful planning is to be visible through invitations, documentation, and planned activities. The operator is responsible for ensuring the printer is in working order to support educators in printing documentation.
- Recommended protective surfacing be added under all climbing equipment to protect a child should they fall.
