Comments: Tires in the outdoor play area were observed containing stagnant rainwater. Please ensure all tires are properly drained to prevent bacterial growth. Possible solutions include drilling big drainage holes, filling the tires with rocks or sand, covering them with a tarp before rainfall, or cutting the tires in half and having them upright. The inspector will return to verify that the tires have been appropriately drained.								
General Comments								
Upon licensing staff arrival for the renewal inspection, children were engaged in various activities such as building with Legos, drawing, and eating snacks after arriving from school. A few minutes later, additional children arrived by bus from another school. Educators were observed actively engaging with the children, including drawing with them and participating in Lego building. One child requested specific craft materials, which the educator promptly provided. Other children were creating forts using blankets and the couch, as well as engaging in pretend play in the kitchen area. Children engaged in free play for the afternoon.								
The indoor environment contained a wide variety of age-appropriate materials, including but not limited to a dramatic play area, foosball table, air hockey table, basketball nets, Lego's, dolls, art supplies, books, and fidget toys.								
Staff and child files were verified on site, and monthly fire drills were confirmed as completed. Children's allergies were clearly posted within the facility.								
A follow-up inspection related to the non-compliance will be conducted prior to recommending the program for renewal.
