<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to introduce themselves as the new Quality Assurance Monitor and conduct a Monitoring Inspection. The facility was bright, organized and welcoming upon arrival. The children were in attendance for a full day today as schools were closed for a PD Day. One small group was observed sitting together at a table making bracelets. The children had a variety of colorful beads and looms to pick from. At another table a child was practicing how to shuffle cards. Educators were sitting at the tables with the children, engaging in the activities and in conversations.</p>

General Comments

Later in the morning a few children told the Educators they were feeling hungry for lunch. The children worked together to clean up their morning activities before they washed their hands for lunch. The group engaged in conversation as they ate. The children were heard talking about different fruits and vegetables they liked and disliked. As the children finished eating, lunch boxes were put away, and they freely explored the classroom. Once all the children had finished eating, they organically gathered at one table. The children were observed using coloring books, white blank paper, markers, pens, tape and other crafting materials.

Once the children lost interest in creating artwork, they cleaned up the craft supplies and prepared to go play outside. Due to low numbers in attendance today, the group decided they would go to the field and play active games. Water bottles, first aid kit and attendance records were brought outside with the group. Once outside, the children picked flowers for the Educators, rolled down a hill and played tag.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. Praise for making good choices was heard throughout the visit. The children appeared comfortable and familiar with the routine and the Educators which made for smooth transition periods. Staff and child profiles were reviewed on site today. While reviewing files it was noted that two child profiles were missing several sections of information. Please have the child profiles filled out and send an email once they have been completed.
