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General Comments
A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon. The children in the Infant Room were observed outdoors with educators, sitting together, playing with balls, and exploring the sandbox. The children in the Two and Three-Year-Old Rooms were observed transitioning from the outdoor play area to their indoor classrooms. Three-Four-Year-Old Room: The children were observed finishing their snack and building with magnetic blocks indoors. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in cars and bridges, baking and cooking, water play, and gross motor activities. School-Age Room: The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments, including during transitions between the two. Indoors, the children were observed playing foosball and basketball, reading books, building with magnetic blocks, and drawing at the table. Outdoors, the children were observed playing soccer. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in sports, crafts, books, and building with blocks. A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, three educator files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills. A conversation took place with the administrator on the following: • Ensure that all children's personal items, including drinking cups, are clearly labelled with the child's name. • Ensure that all medications, including over the counter medications such as Tylenol, are stored in a locked location in accordance with Section 9.2.5 – Storage Space of the Operator Manual. Medications used in the treatment of anaphylaxis are exempt from this requirement and must remain readily accessible. • Ensure that the office door remains locked when not in use, as toxic products, including cleaning agents such as Javex, are stored within the room. Toxic products must always remain inaccessible to children.
