General Comments			

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 25, 2025.

Children were observed during indoor free play. The home operator shared that the children are currently very interested in being active outdoors, building with blocks, participating in the 1000 Hours Outside challenge, engaging in water play, blowing bubbles, and enjoying free play indoors. Positive child guidance techniques were observed, and the operator was actively involved in supporting and extending the children's play.

Outdoor play is scheduled for at least one hour in each four-hour block when the majority of children are present, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and documented. The license, current inspection report, monitoring summaries, and any orders for compliance are posted in a clearly visible and prominent location within the home.

The indoor environment was welcoming and thoughtfully arranged. Materials were intentionally set up to invite children to play. Books that reflect the children's current interests were accessible, and children's artwork was displayed, helping to create a sense of belonging. The home had a varied supply of age-appropriate toys, books, and learning materials, and well-defined play areas were observed.

Snacks are offered at least every three hours, and meals are provided at recognized mealtimes. The weekly menu is posted and includes any substitutions, and parents receive the menu at least three days prior to food being served. Allergy information for children is clearly posted, and evacuation procedures are displayed in a visible location.

All toxic products, including cleaning supplies, were locked and inaccessible to children. Traffic areas and outdoor walkways were clean and free of clutter. Children had access to both individual and group learning opportunities, and various forms of literacy were evident throughout the indoor space.
