Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that a swing structure is not surrounded by a protective surfacing. Stationary equipment must be surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth and is installed according to the manufacturer's instructions. The administrator immediately removed the two swing seats from the structure. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a follow-up inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children engaging in various outdoor play, including riding bicycles, driving small toy cars, swinging, and playing in the sand. The Quality Assurance Monitor has a discussion with the administrator regarding a small Little Tikes slide. Children are not permitted to play on this structure until the operator reviews the manufacturer's instructions to determine whether a protective surface is required. If a protective surface is necessary for the Little Tikes slide, the structure must be surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions. During the visit, the ratio is respected.
